Press the Ignore soft key to stop the phone from ringing <p>Note: Calls unanswered by the end of the ring cycle are typically sent to voicemail.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the Transfer soft key while on an active call OR 2. Press  3. Enter the number or extension 4. Press the Dial soft key 5. Press the Transfer soft key after hearing the ring-back tone or after speaking with the recipient 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press and hold the Transfer soft key while on an active call 2. Press the Blind soft key in the pop-up menu 3. Enter number to complete the transfer

Press the up or down Navigation button to highlight the desired forwarding type: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Always b. Busy c. No Answer 3. Enter the number to forward the calls to 4. Press the Enable soft key 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select Directories from Home View 2. Select Recent Calls 3. Highlight a contact 4. Press the Dial soft key to call the contact 5. Press Info to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Save the contact b. Delete the contact

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Setting up a Conference Call	Managing Conference Calls	Managing People in Conference Calls
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the Conference soft key while on an active call 2. Enter the number of the second caller 3. Press the Conference soft key once the recipient answers <p>Note: Once the Conference soft key is pressed, the first call is automatically put on hold until the Conference soft key is pressed again to join the two calls.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the Hold soft key to place all participants on hold 2. Press the Mute soft key to mute all participants 3. Press End Call to end connection to the conference call. <p>Note: All remaining parties will stay connected.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Highlight a participant and select Manage 2. Select one of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Far Mute – to mute the participant b. Hold – to place the participant on hold c. Remove – to remove the participant from the conference call and create a separate call with the participant d. Information – to view the participants information
Adding or Editing a Contact	Utilizing a Buddy List	Setting up and Accessing Voicemail
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the Add soft key from the Contact Directory 2. Add relevant information to the fields 3. Remove the Index number to stop a contact from appearing as a speed dial <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Press the Info soft key to edit a current contact 5. Press the Edit soft key and amend relevant fields 6. Press the Save soft key when finished 	<p>Add a Buddy</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select a contact from the Contact Directory 2. Press the Edit soft key 3. Navigate to Watch Buddy 4. Select the Enable soft key <p>Call from the Buddy List</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the Buddies soft key from the Lines screen 2. Select the buddy to call 3. Press the Dial soft key to initiate the call 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the Message soft key <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Dial *123 3. Enter the default pin (4-digit extension) 4. Reset pin using the following criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. 4-15 digits b. Nonsequential c. No repetitive digits 5. Follow menu prompts 6. Press  to access voicemail when alerted of a new message (VVX 350 and VVX 450 models only)
