<ol> <li>Press the Conference soft key while on an active call</li> <li>Enter the number of the second caller</li> <li>Press the Conference soft key once the recipient answers</li> <li>Note: Once the Conference soft key is pressed, the first call is automatically put on hold until the Conference soft key is pressed again to join the two calls.</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Press the Hold soft key to place all participants on hold</li> <li>Press the Mute soft key to mute all participants</li> <li>Press End Call to end connection to the conference call.</li> <li>Note: All remaining parties will stay connected.</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Highlight a participant and select Manage</li> <li>Select one of the following:         <ul> <li>a.
